Wednesday, June 30st: Practice round. Tee times must be booked in advance at the office.

18:30 hrs: Welcome Cocktail for all competitors and accompanying guests offered by the Golf de Luxembourg, Domaine de Belenhaff

Thursday, July 1st: First round – 18 holes stroke play.

Friday, July 2nd: Second round – 18 holes stroke play.
Cut for Final round. Best 48 men and best 21 ladies go through to Final round.

Saturday, July 3rd: Final round – 18 holes stroke play.

17:00 hrs: Prize giving ceremony by the Luxembourg Golf Federation.

FOOD and DRINKS

ENTRY CONDITIONS

The Men's Championship is open to all golfers having a maximum handicap of 4.4 or less.
The Ladies' Championship is open to all golfers having a maximum handicap of 9.4 or less
The field will be open to 85 players in the Men's Championship and 35 players for the Ladies' Championship.
The Golf-Club Luxembourg-Belenhaff has the right to invite a limited number of golfers (men and ladies) having a higher handicap.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

1. Registration

Competitors must use the appropriate championship registration form. The closing date for the entries is Monday, 21st June 2021. All entries must be sent by fax (+352 78 71 28) or e-mail (info@golfdeluxembourg.lu) to the Golf-Club Luxembourg-Belenhaff.

The Golf-Club Luxembourg-Belenhaff reserves the right to limit the number of inscriptions. The aim is to have representatives from as many nations as possible and the selection will be made first by country and then by handicap.

A copy of the competitor's exact handicap card or an exact handicap certificate issued by the player's home club must be attached to the registration form.

Entry fee is set at 150.-€ per competitor and must be paid in advance by wire transfer to the Golf-Club Luxembourg-Belenhaff:

Withdrawals

Withdrawals must be notified to the Championship Committee before the draw. No entry fee will be reimbursed.

2. Practice Day

Wednesday 30st June 2021. Tee times **must be reserved in advance at the Club's office.**

3. Starting Times

A list with the starting times for the qualification rounds will be posted on the board of the Club House on Wednesday evening, 30st June 2021 and on our homepage www.golfdeluxembourg.lu and on the Luxemburgish Golf Federation (FLG) side www.figolf.lu

4. Qualifying after 36 holes

The cut will be established after completion of play on Friday the 2nd July in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and in accordance with the local rules approved by the Championship Committee.

The cut will be established from the top 48th and tied men and the top 21st and tied women.

5. Final Stage

The final round shall be played over 1 round of 18 holes stroke play.

The winner will be the player with the lowest amount of strokes over the 3 rounds played.

If there is a tie at the end of the final day, the winner shall be decided by a play-off under the stroke play rules. The time, order of play and the holes to be played will be decided by the Championship Committee.

It is the responsibility of the players concerned to be present at the start of the play-off.

GENERAL RULES

1. Championship Committee

The Championship Committee shall be composed of members designated by the Golf-Club Luxembourg-Belenhaff and the Luxembourg Golf Federation.

In accordance with the Rules of Golf, only the referees appointed for the Championship are authorized to take decisions on the rules, whether or not they are members of the Championship Committee.

The responsibilities of the Championship Committee are defined by the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, Committee procedures section 1 to 9.

The Championship Committee has the right to modify, cancel or take any other decision it considers necessary regarding the rules of the Championship.

2. Official Notice Board

Each competitor shall be aware of the competition rules, the time-table and all other information published on the notice-board at the reception area in the Club house.
